PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

If you are looking for a career in the Skilled Trades this program might be for you. By completing this program in high school, you could enter into your apprenticeship and continue post-secondary training with advanced standing. This is a fantastic addition to your resume.



Student Eligibility & Prerequisites

This program is available to all CESD students:
Prerequisite- Interview and Student High School Endorsement needed for advancement.

1. Who are excited about learning and sharing their ideas
2. Who are in grades 11 or 12 and who have an interest in obtaining their period ONE apprenticeship training in HET.
3. Who are able to commit to the duration of the program, participating in learning activities and completing assignments and tests as scheduled.
4. Who can have all courses completed before the start date of March 23rd. Diploma dates while in programming can be arranged.

Course Outline

Work with both on-and-off road equipment, from heavy transport haulers to excavators — Heavy Equipment Technicians repair and overhaul engines, mechanical and power shift transmissions, hydraulics and basic electrical systems on the largest and most powerful equipment

- Students' marks will appear on their high school transcript as well as their post-secondary transcript.
- Students should have the support and guidance of their parents if they are to pursue online dual credit opportunities.

- Students will be responsible for their OWN transportation for the 12 week program at Olds College.
